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Temporary square and underground car park, 2005
Address: Conegliano, Treviso, Italy. **Client:** Conegliano Servizi S.p.a. **Gross floor area:** 7,220 m²; **parking:** 3,600 m². **Materials:** gravel and wood in the square, concrete and coloured paint in the underground car park.

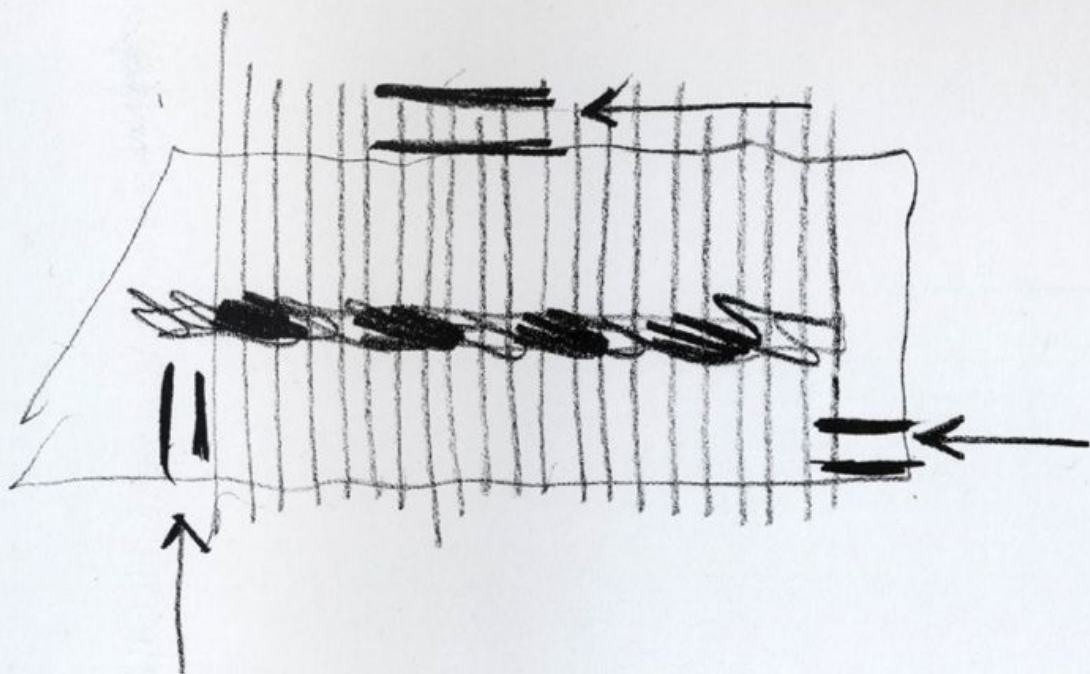
Designed empty spaces, both above and below ground, will form the core elements in a new business district of Treviso. Underground, the two-storey car park shapes the empty space, freeing it of any intruding installations or equipment, which are all concealed in the central shaft. The system of pillars opens up the space like a tunnel, letting natural light flood in. The concrete panels that form the emergency exits are painted green, orange and purple and covered by canopies. These are the only exterior signs of the underground car park. The temporary square is covered entirely in gravel and traversed by a wooden walkway. Colour is used to indicate the parking zones and the emergency exits. Green, orange and purple are used in the design of the area around the emergency exits. Graphic signs in this building become spaces and, conversely, space becomes a graphic solution.
