Lagoon Park presents the installation-event Shel(l)ter.

Shel(l)ter is a shell-refuge in the lagoon park, a rest stop for the traveler, an observation point over the lagoon landscape, an information point.

Through Shel(l)ter the lagoon is perceived, its liquid soil is gauged and the nodes of a new network are laid over the existing ones of the fortified places, the hunting hides, the archaeological sites...

Shel(l)ter offers shelter during the night, as it can be completely closed, and becomes a terrace during the day. It recalls the shells of the hermit crabs on Venice's beaches and the brightly colored "baloni" of the Festa del Redentore.
